Audit of higher education in Scottish universities



This supplement accompanies the main report [Audit of higher education in Scottish universities](#) . Scottish universities are increasingly delivering higher education in other countries, either through their own overseas campuses, in partnership with overseas organisations or through distance learning. This supplement describes examples of the locations and types of higher education delivered around the world by Scottish universities.

University	Examples of Scottish higher education around the world
The University of Aberdeen	<p>Hadong County, South Korea</p> <p>The University is in very advanced negotiations to conclude an agreement to open a campus in Hadong County, South Korea, with student intake in 2017. The initiative is in partnership with a local institution as well as central and local government. The campus will see the delivery of, initially, programmes in engineering and energy management and will offer opportunities for research and connections with industry, as well as student recruitment.</p>
Edinburgh Napier University	<p>Hong Kong</p> <p>Edinburgh Napier is the largest UK provider of education in Hong Kong, with more than 3,000 students enrolled every year. Edinburgh Napier partners with Hong Kong University and City University of Hong Kong to deliver their programmes.</p> <p>India</p> <p>Edinburgh Napier offers a Bachelor of Engineering and Computing at the International Institute of Information Technology in Kolkata (Calcutta) in India.</p>
The University of Dundee	<p>Kenya</p> <p>The University of Dundee's distance learning centre (Nursing and Palliative Care) provides a Bachelor of Nursing and a Masters of Nursing programme by distance learning, in partnership with the Kenya Medical Training College.</p>
The University of Glasgow	<p>Tianjin, China</p> <p>The University of Glasgow-Nankai University Joint Graduate School opened in 2015. The dual Masters qualifications on offer include Environmental Management, International Relations, and Urban and Regional Planning.</p>

The University of Glasgow	<p data-bbox="584 288 762 320">Muscat, Oman</p> <p data-bbox="584 360 1449 495">The University of Glasgow's School of Education partnered with Majan University College (MUC) in Muscat, Oman in April 2011. The partnership involves delivery of The University of Glasgow's MSc in Organisational Leadership.</p>
Glasgow Caledonian University (GCU)	<p data-bbox="584 517 847 548">London and New York</p> <p data-bbox="584 589 1458 757">GCU has campuses in London and New York. In addition to offering postgraduate programmes in a range of key areas, GCU London is home to the British School of Fashion. The Fair Fashion Centre is based at GCU New York, and works closely with the United Nations and industry leaders to promote sustainability in fashion business.</p> <p data-bbox="584 797 911 828">Johannesburg, South Africa</p> <p data-bbox="584 869 1453 1003">GCU is working in partnership with The University of Johannesburg and the Institution of Railway Operators to deliver a BSc in Railway Operations Management. The course is delivered by Learning Contract to South Africa's largest freight rail organisation, Transnet Freight Rail.</p>
Glasgow School of Art (GSA)	<p data-bbox="584 1014 703 1046">Singapore</p> <p data-bbox="584 1086 1453 1263">In September 2012, GSA partnered with the Singapore Institute of Technology and Temasek Polytechnic. Years 3 and 4 of GSA's Bachelor of Arts (Hons) Programmes in Communication Design and Interior Design are delivered in Singapore. The programmes enable Diploma students to progress from a Diploma to a Bachelor of Arts (Hons) degree.</p>
Heriot-Watt University	<p data-bbox="584 1274 919 1305">Dubai, United Arab Emirates</p> <p data-bbox="584 1346 1445 1480">Heriot-Watt University's Dubai campus opened in 2005 and provides higher education to over 3,500 students. The campus provides a range of programmes from foundation level to PhD programmes in the fields of engineering, business and management, built environment and textiles.</p>
Heriot-Watt University	<p data-bbox="584 1512 810 1543">Putrajaya, Malaysia</p> <p data-bbox="584 1583 1461 1794">Heriot-Watt University's Malaysia campus opened to students in Putrajaya in 2014 and currently has 1,000 students. The University provides a range of career-focused and professionally relevant programmes from foundation to postgraduate level in business, finance, energy, built environment and a range of engineering specialisms specifically tailored to the Malaysian and the South East Asian economic need.</p>

Open University in Scotland	<p data-bbox="584 288 671 320">Malawi</p> <p data-bbox="584 360 1422 528">The Open University has been working in Malawi since 2010 delivering teacher training to increase the presence of women in rural primary schools. This includes working on a DFID-funded project, Keeping Girls in School – Malawi Access to Teaching Scholarship (KGIS-MATS) that delivers training to teachers and teaching assistants.</p> <p data-bbox="584 568 663 600">Russia</p> <p data-bbox="584 640 1453 842">The International Institute of Management LINK (IIM LINK) is using The Open University's teaching model to develop a new management culture in Russia. IIM LINK now reaches over 70,000 students across Russia, the Commonwealth of Independent States (CIS) and the Baltic countries. A portfolio of Open University business and management qualifications are offered through IIM LINK for an OU award. Programmes include:</p> <ul data-bbox="584 882 1430 1084" style="list-style-type: none"> - the internationally-recognised MBA qualification, presented in English - the Professional Certificate and Diploma in Management, presented in Russian - the BA (Hons) in Business Studies degree, presented in Russian.

University of St Andrews	<p>Global</p> <p>The University of St Andrews offers a variety of programmes jointly with The College of William and Mary, Virginia, USA; University of Washington and Lee, Virginia, USA; and the University of Alberta, Canada.</p>
The University of Stirling	<p>Singapore</p> <p>Stirling University, through the Institute for Retail Studies, has been working with the Singapore Retail Association since 1989. An MBA in Retailing by distance learning was launched in 1996, and this two-year programme operates in partnership with the Retail Academy of Singapore. In addition, a BA (Hons) in Retail Marketing is offered, which is delivered in partnership with the Singapore Institute of Management (SIM). The programme is taught primarily by members of the Institute for Retail Studies, supported by local tutors. Undergraduate students based in Singapore have the option of studying at the Stirling campus in semester 7.</p>
University of Strathclyde	<p>Global</p> <p>Strathclyde Business School offers a number of postgraduate programmes via a network of overseas teaching centres. These are permanent Strathclyde-branded operations in collaboration with a local partner. Academics from The University of Strathclyde visit to undertake the core teaching, and the local centres offer academic support between teaching periods. Programmes offered include MBAs in Oman, Switzerland, Malaysia, Singapore, Dubai, Bahrain, Abu Dhabi, and Greece; and a MSc Finance in Tanzania.</p>
University of the West of Scotland (UWS)	<p>Global</p> <p>UWS offers a number of collaborative programmes overseas including:</p> <p>Siberian State Transport University, Russia – Msc International Management (Franchise Model)</p> <p>University of Angers, France – MSc Quality Management (International) and MSc Project Management (International) (Dual Award)</p> <p>University of Seychelles, Seychelles – MBA (Franchise Model)</p> <p>Filmbase, Ireland – MA Creative Media Practice (Franchise Model).</p>
